

Curious to know how superior aerodynamics can impact your bottom line? It's simple. Calculate your own fuel savings by finding your current MPG on the left. The columns on the right show your approximate dollar savings per year as you improve your fuel economy (actual savings may vary depending on driving conditions and vehicle configuration). The chart assumes you drive 125,000 miles a year and fuel costs \$2.32 per gallon.



Notice the aerodynamically-sloped hood with its small, contemporary grille. The swept-back fenders. The rounder, smoother, more contoured profile, with an upturned sweep at the top to direct wind upward and over an optimally-curved windshield. There's a lot less air resistance at the leading edge of this truck. Add full-length chassis fairings, and side extenders and you've reduced aerodynamic drag even more.







The T600's 46-inch setback front axle helps drivers optimize and maneuver loads with ease.





In a world that tends to relax standards in pursuit of something new, Kenworth still believes that traditional, time-proven ways have their contemporary application.

It's easy to be influenced by the sleek good looks of the T600. To be attracted by the pure pleasure of owning the best, most prestigious aerodynamic truck on the road. But the true beauty of your T600 lies under the skin – in the form of day in, day out dependability, mechanical integrity and longevity. • Take the cab as just one example. Legendary for its toughness, a Kenworth cab combines aluminum and fiberglass in an assembly that's practically corrosion-proof. Huckbolts hold all the pieces together with a clamping force six times greater than rivets, so the cab's strong, tight and more rattle-free. • Then there are all the little things you might not notice that help keep big things from going wrong. Wiring and plumbing are bundled together and mounted high inside the frame to help keep them safe from chafing, road salts or washing acids. Rubber-bushed pins and bushings extend front suspension life and improve steering. Constant torque hose clamps stay tight. Radiator tie rods mounted to the frame – not the cab – prolong cab life. And so much more.

Huckbolts hold with six times the Constant torque hose clamps – standard on Kenworth trucks – go on tight and stay that way.



Coil-coated aluminum panels and a one-piece fiberglass roof, supported by an aircraft-grade aluminum alloy frame, produce a lightweight yet durable cab that is virtually immune to corrosion.



Thick bulkhead-type doors hang on continuous stainless steel piano hinges - not typical automotive hinges - and fit snugly to become an integral part of the cab structure – another reason Kenworth trucks bring more at resale than just about any other make you can name.






When it comes to maintenance, you'll soon discover there's plenty of value in what you don't spend on a T600.

Sitting in a service bay costs you productive time on the road. That's why on a T600, serviceable components are easier and quicker to get to, less strenuous to take apart and faster to put back together. • Tip the hood and you'll see what we mean. The engine sits high in the frame and totally ahead of the cab for complete access. You can check fluid levels and change fuel, oil and water filters while standing on the ground – not on a tire. The heater/air conditioner motor, electrical master connectors, windshield wiper motor and washer reservoir are all on the firewall, easier to repair. • Now take a close look at the engine cooling system. On a T600, it combines straight sections of reinforced rubber hose – more readily available and less expensive to replace than preformed hoses – with steel elbows that are good for a lifetime of service. • Even the electrical system – a maintenance headache for many operators – has been designed for durability and streamlined troubleshooting. Multiplex instrumentation greatly simplifies cab wiring which is further color-coded and numbered for easy circuit tracing. • Quick-to-fix engineering features like these can mean a lot less downtime, shop time and money out of your pocket.




The T600's power distribution box puts all circuit protection elements – fuses, relays and breakers – in one quick-to-reach location.



Kenworth's frame is a continuous straight rail constructed of heat-treated steel – custom-drilled to specification – offering superior strength and longevity. Extruded aluminum crossmembers and aluminum gussets – in standard designs for easy replacement – add additional foundation without adding a lot of extra weight. And all the components are free-fit fastened for extended life. Notice how Kenworth mounts all air and electrical lines high in the frame, away from potential sources of heat, caustic chemicals and mechanical abrasion.



Servicing the battery system is easier on a fairing-equipped T600 than on most trucks. Only 5 bolts stand in the way of complete access.
