



These powerplants are rated at 310 or 330 horsepower and have the durability and stamina to get the job done.

Potholes? What potholes?




Mirrors reflecting smart thinking.

Components are mounted in the same place on every Granite chassis making each installation as easy as the next.

Getting a new body is no sweat.

Mack components — step brackets, cable mount air tanks and battery boxes — are all permanently positioned forward of the rear of the cab. This ensures body compatibility while eliminating costly component relocation. Two 19-pin industry-certified Body Link™ wire harness connectors are conveniently located on the firewall under the hood and under the dash panel for quick hookup. Body Link connectors provide easy access to standard power requirements and V-MAC data.

Wheelbases and axle ratings galore.

Versatility comes standard on the Granite model. With a full range of wheelbase options, front axle ratings from 12,000 to 20,000 pounds, and rear axles from 38,000 to 65,000 pounds, this Bulldog is ready to tackle any jobsite. 





Granite cab lighting lets drivers work easier. Fixtures are precisely positioned to reduce annoying glare that causes eye strain and fatigue. When opened, optional interior door panel lights illuminate the steps. In short, you won't find a more comprehensive lighting package on a vocational truck.

Electronics that drive efficiency.

Here's the one thing to remember about Mack electronics: it's all integrated. That means everything is designed to work together for better operation and fewer hassles. The foundation of our electronics system is V-MAC. With more than 100 programmable features, V-MAC helps you run at peak efficiency. From the trip recorder and vehicle diagnostics to the electronic dash and engine brake, V-MAC controls and monitors hundreds of parameters. Connected to V-MAC is our Vehicle Information Profiler (V.I.P.). This large in-dash display keeps drivers notified about engine/vehicle performance, fuel economy, trip data as well as maintenance and PTO information. An option on Granite is our GuardDog™ maintenance monitor. Working with V.I.P., GuardDog tells drivers when engine oil and selected filters need to be changed and when fluid levels are low. With GuardDog, maintenance data comes from real-time sensors instead of preprogrammed schedules based on mileage. The result? More accurate information to keep your truck up and running.
