An in-depth examination of the Mercedes-Benz LP-Series trucks reveals a range of contemporary Class 7 cabover-engine vehicles that are as long on performance as they are on efficiency.

To achieve these results, Mercedes-Benz engineers, manufactures and rigorously specifies all major components.

Which means a medium-duty truck that's completely integrated from the ground up.

In keeping with the Mercedes-Benz trucks tradition, the utmost importance has been placed on driver productivity in the LP Series. That's

why all-around visibility, an attribute of the C.O.E. design, is unequaled by any competitor. Maneuverability, made possible by a set-back front axle and sharp front wheel cut, is second to none. And maintenance accessibility, afforded by the tilt-forward cab, keeps downtime

At the core of the LP-Series are two world-proven sources of power. The turbocharged and intercooled OM 366LA is an efficient 6-cylinder, in-line diesel utilized in the LP straight truck models. The heavy-duty, full-range OM 429LA is a hightorque 5-cylinder diesel and is utilized in


The OM 3661 A, as used in models LP 1219 and LP 1419, is a 6-cylinder in-line turbocharged and

intercooled full range diesel engine. It incorporates oil-cooled

pistons and dry cylinder sleeves for longer service life and lower repair costs. Charge air intercooling lowers the engine intake air temperature

after turbocharging, resulting in more power, lower combustion temperatures, lower thermal stress, reduced emissions and better fuel economy. Pulling

power for big loads and steep grades is ensured with a healthy 450 lbf. ft. (431 lbf.ft. in Calif.) of torque at 1400 RPM.


