The three core Axor rigid chassis are the 18 tonnes gvw 4x2 and a pair of 26 tonners, one a 6x2, the other a 6x4. These are variously offered with a choice of 6.4 or 7.2 litre engines rated at 238, 286 and 326hp.

Then there's a choice of three individual cabs - extended day, low roof sleeper, and high roof sleeper.

Together with a comprehensive range of wheelbases.

Additionally, there are also chassis for more specialist applications such as a heavy duty Axor 4x2 for skiploader and construction use, a 4x4, a range of drawbar chassis and an urban artic.

Axor's appeal is therefore direct, straightforward and fully focused.

The 4x2 rigid, for example, is available with a full choice of lightweight, fuel-efficient engines rated at 238, 286 or 326hp. As such, it's the ideal chassis not just for almost every size and type of bodywork, but for solo and drawbar operation as well.

Similarly, the 6x2 rigid has been configured as a highly cost-effective haulage chassis able to carry significantly more payload and even bigger truck bodies. The 6x4, principally aimed at the tipper and mixer markets, is also offered in a longer wheelbase variant that's ideal for crane applications, tankers, and general purpose haulage work.

Precisely for such versatility, operators of every type choose Axor for its convincing all-round performance.

The get up and go

Designed to perform

Axor middleweight trucks use either 6.4 or 7.2 litre six cylinder engines.

Designed and developed exclusively by Mercedes-Benz, these powerplants are noted for their light weight, fuel economy and reliability.

Virtues that are now more in demand than ever.

Well-spaced horsepower outputs of either 238, 286 or 326hp mean that there's an Axor engine that's just right for every application. Noteworthy too is the fact that these engines also develop healthy maximum torque outputs of 850, 1120 and 1300Nm respectively, all developed between 1200 and 1600rpm. In every operating environment, Axor's performance is impressive.

Matched to either 6 or 9 speed manual gearboxes, Axor drivelines deliver a convincing balance of smooth, relaxed progress with the ability to handle every type of terrain. Also available with the 238hp engine is a 2 pedal automated transmission, making driving notably easier not just out on the open road, but particularly in town centres where multi-drop and retail operations predominate.

Axor also brings another key benefit to urban operations as well - the MSS engine start/stop system which switches off the engine when the vehicle is waiting in traffic. Offered as standard in the UK with all Axor 6.4 and 7.2 litre engines, MSS cuts the engine if the vehicle is stationary, in neutral gear and the clutch pedal not being operated. Instant restart occurs when the clutch pedal is depressed and a gear selected prior to moving off.

Not only does MSS save unnecessary fuel consumption, but also makes a significant contribution in reducing emissions, pollution and noise. In their latest Euro 5 specifications Axor engines are among the cleanest available, bringing obvious benefits with environmental issues as highlighted by the Reduced Pollution Certificate and London Exclusion Zone.



Cabs

Designed to perform

With three different cabs, Axor is at home in every operating environment.

Saving both weight and cost, the extended day cab is ideal for urban applications and multi-drop deliveries. It's also the cab that helps provide the longest possible bodywork.

Axor's low roof sleeper cab is ideal for drivers spending occasional nights away. Combining a light and airy workplace with generous storage capacity and a high quality bed, the low roof sleeper offers the opportunity for both relaxed rest breaks and a good night's sleep.

But for many hauliers and their drivers, particularly those whose trucks might be away most of the working week, the high roof sleeper is unquestionably the Axor cab of choice. Easy to move around in and with more living and storage space than ever, this cab delivers for its driver around the clock.

Therefore, many of Axor's cab features are common to all three models, with numerous options also available.

The similarly curved instrument binnacle means that the visibility and operation of all controls are clear, straightforward and uncomplicated. The driver's sense of comfort and well-being are further amplified by a first-class, multi-adjustable air suspension seat and a steplessly adjustable steering column to provide the most comfortable driving position possible.

Axor is today's multi-purpose chassis par excellence.

At 18 tonnes gcw, the 4x2 chassis offers a choice of nine wheelbases from 3900 to 6300mm to answer almost every operating and bodybuilding requirement.

Curtainsider and boxvan bodied Axors are therefore firm favourites with retail and distribution operators, where day-in, day-out reliability and first rate fuel economy are absolute operating requirements.

But Axor offers more. Being easy to drive with straightforward controls, it's also an ideal truck for temporary staff and agency drivers to use. Ever practical, simple to operate and relaxing to drive, Axor is equally at home on the short run or the long haul.

Moving up to to 26 tonnes gvw, heavier Axors arguably offer even greater benefits. Spec for spec, a 6x2 Axor 2533 typically weighs around 1 tonne more than the 4x2 Axor 1824, thereby providing an additional 7 tonnes body and payload allowance.

Axor 6x4 and 4x2 – built to take it.

Similarly, longer wheelbase Axor 6x4s are often used in more onerous haulage applications such as milk tankers on farm collection work, brick carriers and beavertail bodied plant and machinery transporters.

Out on the road, the dynamic qualities of the truck - precise steering, predictable handling, superior ride and powerful ABS braking (with Telligent® option) - all speak for themselves. But if an accident does occur, the high strength, all steel cab shell (easily surpassing the ECE-R-29 safety standard) will have a vital role to play.

For example, Axor is capable of running on up to 100% Bio-diesel (EN14214) without modification.
